You can collect your computer account at webkonto.student.hig.se two weeks before the semester starts. Your computer account gives you access to the University web services.

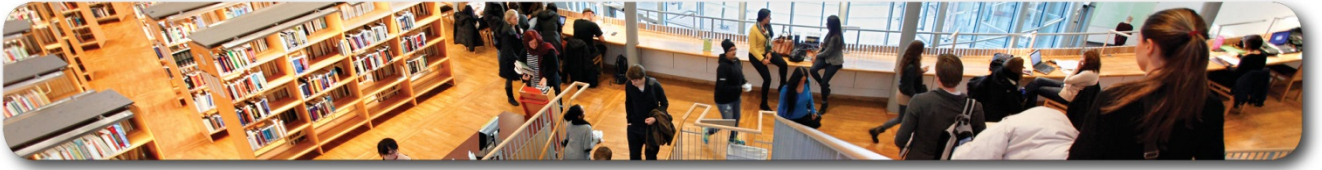

3 BLACKBOARD

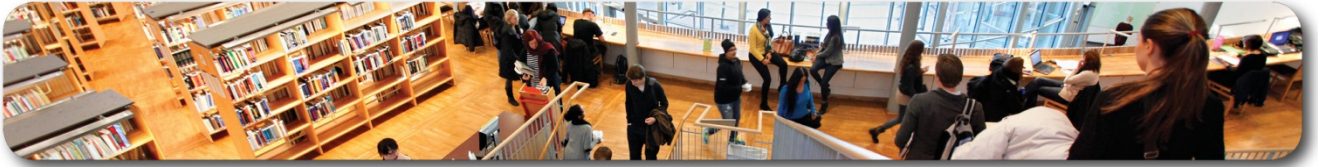
The Blackboard platform is a web-based learning management system where you can find course material. Log in via the Student Portal, find your course and enroll.

Welcome to the University of Gävle and to the English Introductory Course

My name is Lisa Johansson and I am the course coordinator of this course.

In this letter you will find basic information about our course and our department. To start with it is important that you register on Blackboard which will be our main channel for communication. This is where you will find material about our course such as the time table, instructions, assignments, power point presentations etc. This is also where the different instructors will post general announcements concerning the course and the individual sessions. Please note that the time table for the first modules will be posted by the end of week one which is the first week of January.

You need to obtain a student account at Studentportalen. This is where you register for exams and where you get access to your results.

An introduction day will be held on Monday January 25. During this day you will receive general information about the University of Gävle and you will have an opportunity to meet other international students. A time table for this day will be posted on Blackboard.

Teaching will start Tuesday January 26 between 10am – 3pm. We will meet in room 31:524.

During the first session you will receive an introduction of the course and you will also have an opportunity to introduce yourself to your peers. We will start with modules 1 and 4 which will be taught parallel. You therefore need to obtain all the course literature listed for these modules before the course starts.

Furthermore, to participate fully in our courses it is important that you prepare well for the seminars by reading instructed parts of the course literature. This is obligatory and vital in order to be able to participate in discussing particular models and issues brought up in the literature, rather than discussing topics in general. Therefore it is important that you get hold of the literature well in time for the relevant sessions. If you have troubles finding a particular title I can recommend that you visit www.amazon.co.uk. There you might also be able to find the titles second hand for a good price.

For your written assignments you should follow standards and procedures for academic writing. That means for example that you make clear distinctions between arguments and thoughts of your own and those of others by using one of the standard systems for referencing. In terms of language it means that you use formal written language. However, since this is also something you will develop as part of our courses it is important that you already from the beginning pay attention to all the comments given by your instructors.
