Get Started with Your Studies!

To get started with your studies please follow these three steps. More information at hig.se/newstudent

1 Obtain an HiG Computer Account

You can obtain your HiG computer account at webkonto.student.hig.se two weeks before the semester starts. (week 34). Your computer account consists of a username and a password and gives you access to the University web services, including the electronic learning platform you will use for this course, Blackboard.

2 Register on HiG's Student Portal

You must be registered here in order to take the course. Registering here also gives you a link to the course's Blackboard site within 24 hours. (the link will appear on your own studentportalen pages) You will lose your place on the course if you do not register in time. Log in to Blackboard

The Blackboard platform is a web-based learning management system where your course is located. The day after you register on studentportalen the course title will appear on your studentportalen pages as a link.
