My name is Caroline Sims and I am the course coordinator for the upcoming VFU period in English **ENG513 7,5 cr. and ENG514 15 cr.**

In this letter you will find some initial information about the course and our expectations of your work in, what I assume, will be your last VFU-period with us.

The period runs between weeks 14-23. On **Friday the 3 of June** there will be a day for presentations as part of the examination on campus in Gävle. Participation this day is mandatory. In total that means that you will be expected to do 46 days at your VFU school. I would also like to emphasize that you are expected to do time equal to working 100%, which for a teacher means 45 hours-a-week. Remember also that this includes participation in all types of activities a teacher position at upper secondary level involves and not only teaching.

The skills and abilities this particular VFU period aim to examine is for you to:

- Apply the educational curriculum to the teaching of English
- Demonstrate the ability to create adequate conditions for all students to learn and improve their knowledge within the subject of English
- Plan, carry out, and establish objectives for teaching activities within the subject of English
- Observe, document, analyze, and assess students' progress in relation to the teaching objectives.

As can be seen in the course plan it is also important that you behave in a professional manner in connection to you contact with fellow students and teachers, and equally represent the values and principles underlying the educational system. Remember also that you are not at the school in private but as a representative of our college and therefore act in a professional manner. I am in no doubt that you will do so.

You will be set two specific examination exercises to do with your classes under supervision by your LLU. There will also be a report to write. About this and for additional information I would like to meet you all on ***Tuesday 29th of March 31:470*** between 13-14 o'clock.
